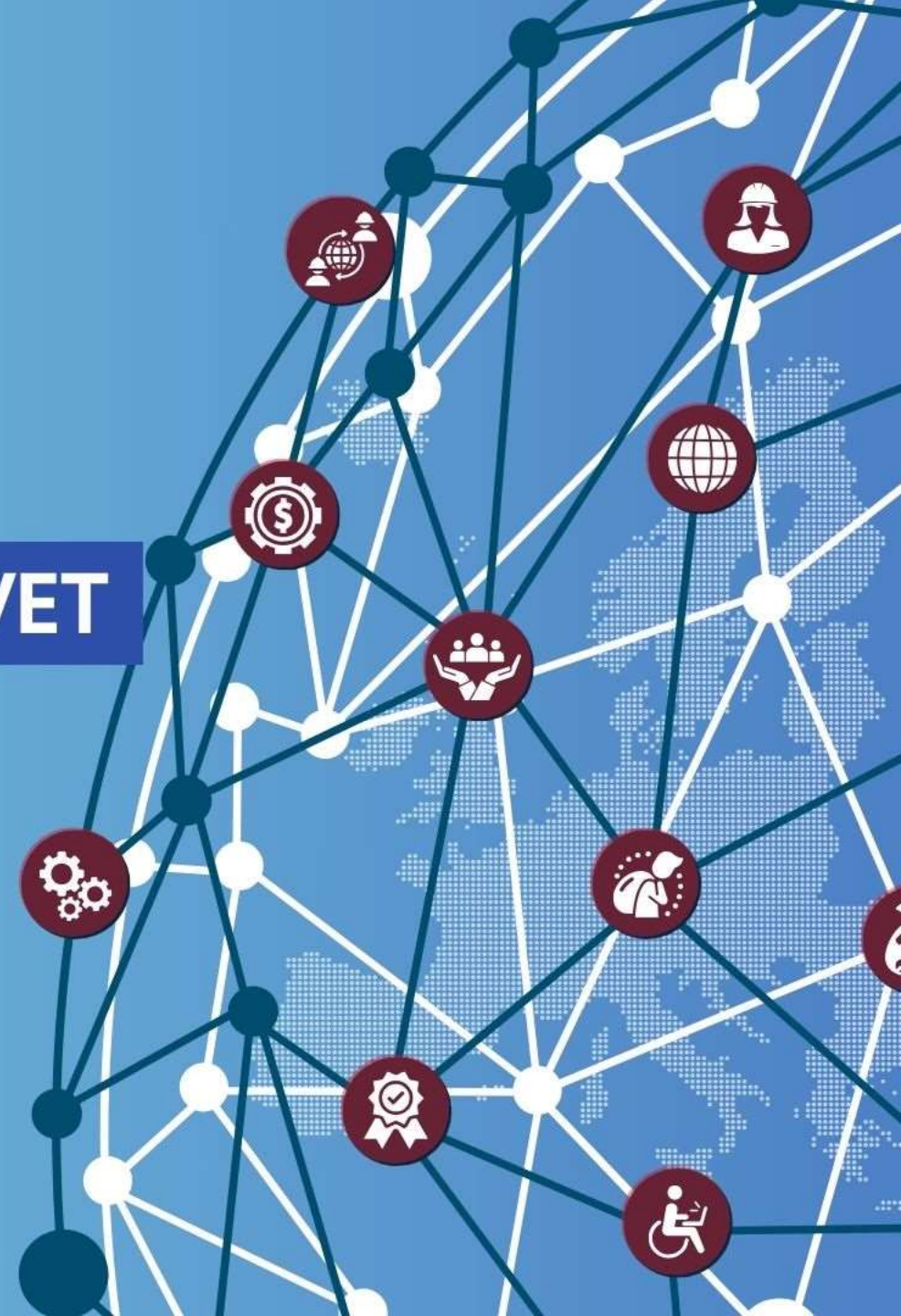



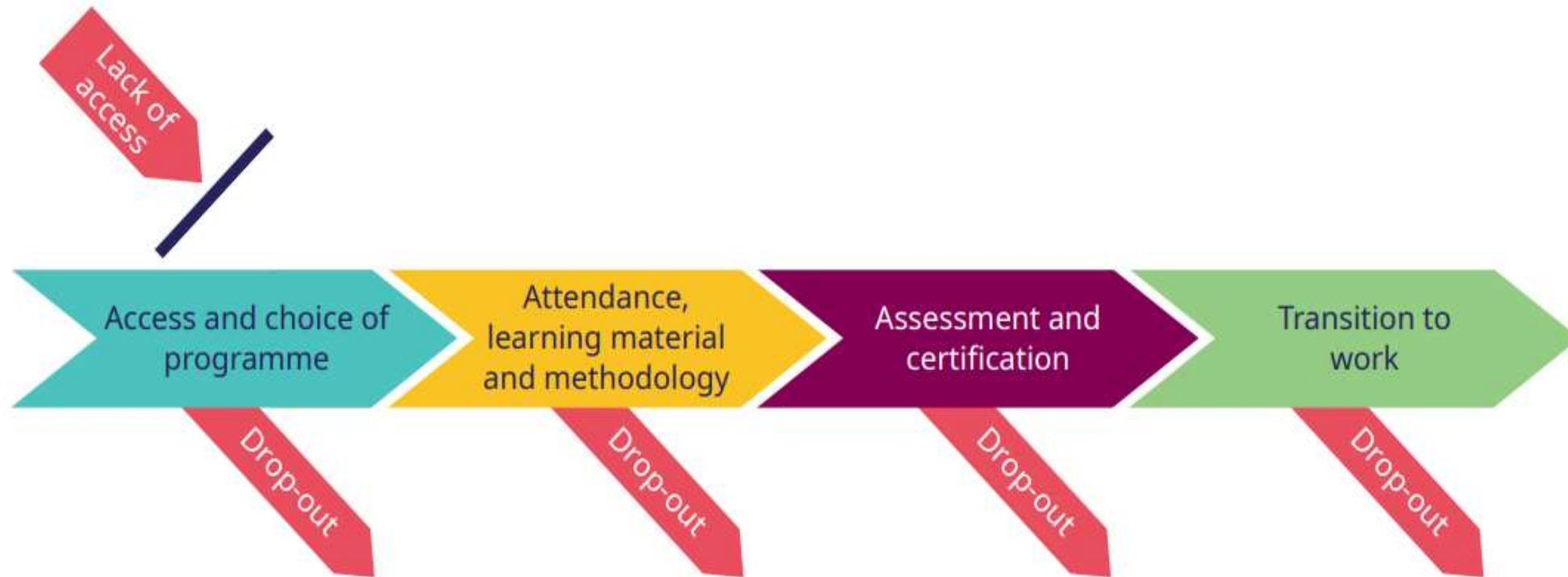

► Figure 1. Inclusive TVET – Where exclusion might happen



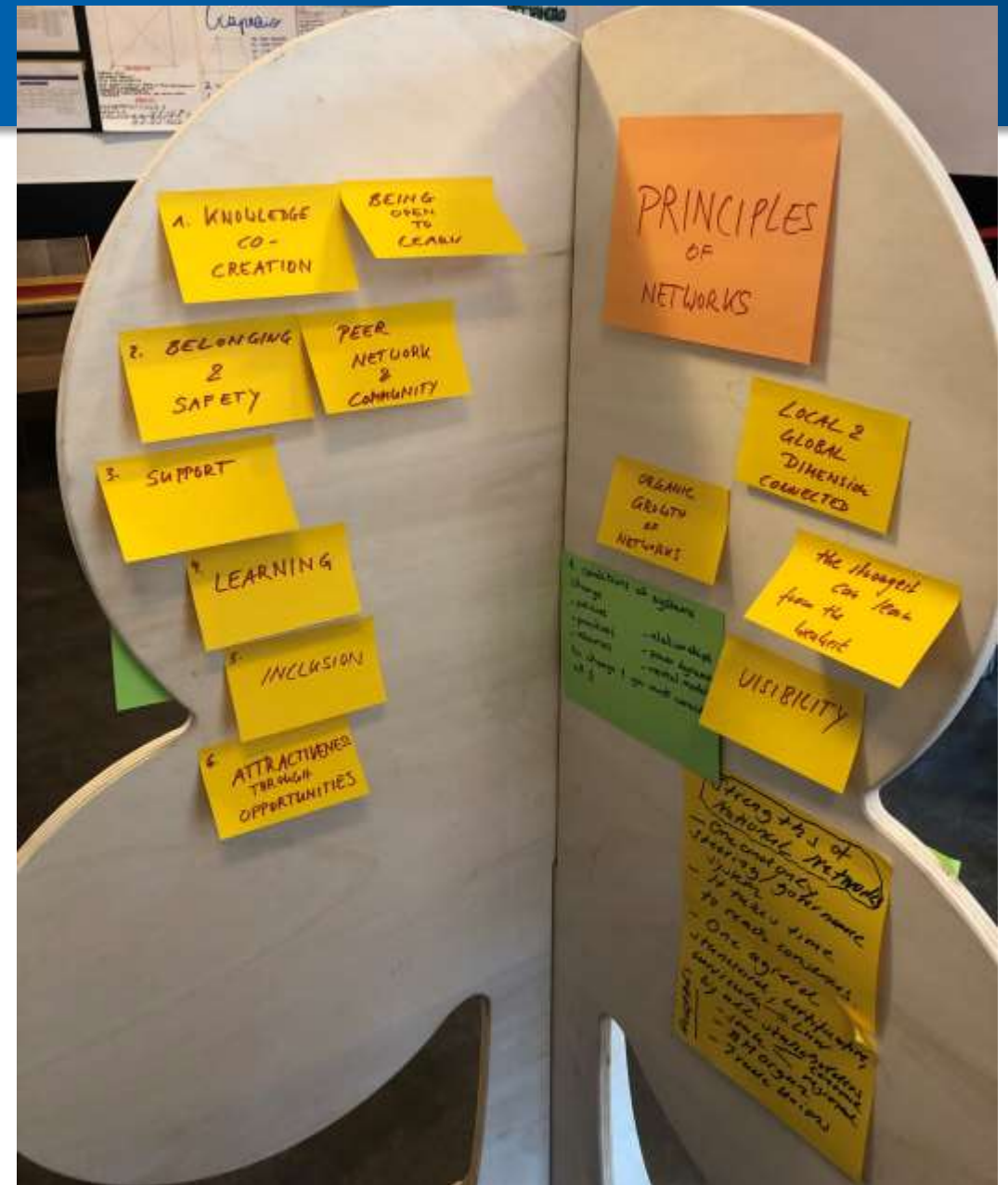

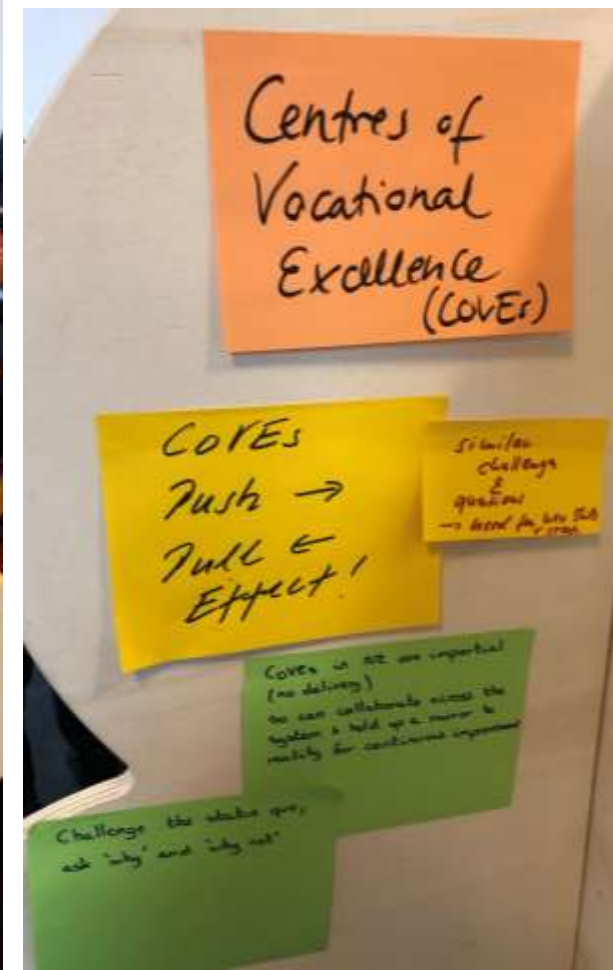
## Principles of Networks
